Museum reaps rewards with Boy Scout Eagle Award project

Ryan Patterson, 16-year old son of Chris and Lynn Alison Patterson of O'Fallon, recently completed his Eagle Scout Award project by transforming a second-floor room at the O'Fallon Historical Museum into a memorial to this city's long scouting tradition.

A member of Troop 85, sponsored by First Baptist Church of O'Fallon, Patterson created display racks and assembled cases on which he has arrayed the museum's collection of scouting-related patches, neckerchiefs, coffee mugs and uniforms. He and fellow Scouts carried two glass display cases up the steep stairs leading to the museum's second floor.

He also placed more than 100 articles about local Scouts in scrapbooks. The O'Fallon Township High School sophomore began planning the project in November and completed it in February.

Ryan and his project were featured in an *O'Fallon Progress* article March 19.

A Salute to Historic Preservation Month

May is Historic Preservation Month and the national theme chosen for this year is "This Place Matters." Indeed it does.

That's a point our Society has been driving home for what will be 21 years in May. Knowing the history of a community gives it context. Awareness of that history provides the roots from which the community grows and fosters a sense of cohesiveness, belonging and identity. A community that neglects the preservation of its historical memory risks losing the very essence of its being.

Each year for Historical Preservation Month, the O'Fallon Historic Preservation Commission sponsors a landmark awards ceremony and house tour. This year, the old Moonlight Hall at First and Cherry, is receiving a city landmark award in recognition of

its wonderful restoration by owners Brad and Timi McMillin. Built in 1903 with the second floor "hall" added in 1908, this building was for many years a center of O'Fallon entertainment and recreation.

The landmark presentation will be at 1 p.m. on Saturday May 30 inside the restored building. The house tour will begin from there at 1:30 p.m. and will continue until 3:30 p.m. As of this writing, which landmark houses in O'Fallon that will be on the tour is still being worked out. But a list and map will be available at the ceremony that day.

The public is welcome and encouraged to attend both the ceremony and the tour. There is no charge for admission. If nothing else, please come and tour the Moonlight Hall and see how the McMillins have restored it to its

original glory.

While you're at it, don't forget to stop by the museum if you haven't lately. Our Lincoln exhibit is still on display through May. Also, Ryan Patterson has just finished fixing up the Boy Scout Room on the second floor as an Eagle Scout Project -- it's very well done and a museum "must-see." And we recently received what must be among our most interesting items ever donated -- two Friendship Quilts from the O'Fallon United Church of Christ which is described elsewhere in this newsletter.

As always, many thanks to our dedicated and selfless volunteers who keep our museum open three days a week and to our many supporters and friends. It is because of you that history is being preserved in O'Fallon.

Friendship quilts are among donations

Occasionally the O'Fallon Historical Society gets an item that is historical and well as beautiful folk art. Recently the museum received two quilts donated by the United Church of Christ, and Elaine Berger and Audrey Klein.

Friendship quilts have been popular since before the Civil War. They record memories of cherished friends and church members. Quilting bees were important social occasions for women who had no other contact with each other in their busy lives.

The Ladies Guild of the O'Fallon Evangelical Church asked the quilters of the church to create a Friendship Quilt as a money-making project. The first one, embroidered with blue thread, sold spaces for people to have their names put on it for 10 cents each. The quilt held 388 names, so income was \$38.80, minus cost of materials. We estimate the cut-off date for the blue quilt names was about 1928-1929. The quilt has been used and was in storage at the UCC church before the Ladies

Guild donated it to our museum in March 2009.

A second quilt, embroidered with pink thread, was made about eight years later, the cut-off date was possibly between August

1936 and March 1937. It contains 551 names and was given by the guild to Mrs. Emma B. Klemme. Her daughters, Elaine Berger and Audrey Klein, donated the quilt to the museum, also in March 2009.

Both quilts include names of women, men and children from the Evangelical Church and from other churches. Each of these quilts was penned by one person with pretty handwriting and then embroidered. The list of names on each of these quilts is printed in full on the following pages. The exact location of individual names on the quilts is available at the museum. Please let us know if you know more of the story about these quilts or name corrections.
